Exam Rules and Regulations: ข้อปฏิบัติในการเข้าห้องสอบ

1. Students must show their student ID cards.
2. Students are not allowed to enter the examination room later than 30 minutes after the examination has started.
3. Use pen or pencil to write student's name and seat number in every answer sheet.
4. Students may not bring the materials (such as notes, books, and calculator) to the examination room.
5. Wrist watch (without active alarm or programmable capability) is permitted in examination room.
6. Students must not talk to or borrow any materials from another student.
7. No one is allowed to take the examination paper out of the examination room.
8. Students are not allowed to leave the room until the time has expired.
